Downtown San Jose site for homeless street youth (ages 12-24) provides services and basic necessities to help exit street life.

Family Advocacy Services

High-school based homeless prevention and intervention services.

Parenting Class

The Systematic Training for Effective Parenting (S.T.E.P.) program builds communication skills between parents and youth ages 12-17.

Probation Diversion & Rehabilitation Services

Case management and 24/7 crisis support designed to prevent recidivism.

Safe Place


Designated safe havens at businesses, schools and social service agencies for youth.
